<u>s</u>: 1. The analytical results submitted in ADAMS. The reporting time specified in item 8.3 shall be started upon receive the sample and all chain of custody document.

- Upon requesting for the sample B analysis, the customer must appoint the witness (ref: WADA International Standards for Laboratories (current version)). If there is no appointed witness from the customer, NDCC shall appoint a surrogate (independent witness) to be the witness. The customer must responsible for witness's charge as stated in the service charge schedule of NDCC.
- 3. In case NDCC contract TA or RMA regarding approved TUE. TA should document response to this contact within 3 working days, otherwise NDCC will proceed the confirmation process in accordance with ISL (current version).
- 4. The samples without AAF or ATF shall be retained frozen as the "A" and "B" Samples, for a minimum of 3 months after the reporting the final result in ADAMS, unless customer requested to long-term storage. The customer shall pay the storage fee.
- 5. The sample with AAF or ATF shall be stored as frozen the "A" and "B" samples, for a minimum of 6 months after reporting the final result in ADAMS unless customer requested to long-term storage. The customer shall pay the storage fee
- 6. As per ISL regarding acceptance of sample from non-signatory (current version) the laboratory may accept sample from nonsignatory organization, however, the analysis result shall not be approved under WADA accreditation and not reported in ADAMS. The laboratory will send the result as directly to the organization.
